1 Corinthians 11:17 - 1 Corinthians 15:11

1 Corinthians 11

1. 11:20-21 For as you eat, each of you goes ahead without waiting for anybody else. One remains hungry, another gets drunk.
2. 11:23 What I received from the Lord.
3. 11:26 Whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup.
4. 11:27 Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner.
5. 11:28-29 For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself.
6. 11:31 We would not come under judgment.
7. 11:32 So that we will not be condemned with the world.

1 Corinthians 12

1. 12:2 When you were pagans.
2. 12:3 That no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.
3. 12:7 The manifestation of the Spirit.
4. 12:11 The Spirit (one and the same Spirit).
5. 12:12 The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ.
6. 12:13 We--whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free.
7. 12:15 The foot, if it should say, "Because I am not a hand I do not belong to the body".
8. 12:18 Just as he wanted them to be.
9. 12:22 Those parts of the body that seem to be weaker.
10. 12:24-25 So that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.
11. 12:28 First of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those having gifts of healing, those able to help others, those with gifts of administration, and those speaking in different kinds of tongues.
12. 12:31 The greater gifts.

1 Corinthians 13

1. 13:2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love.
2. 13:3 If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love.
3. 13:6 Love.
4. 13:11 When I became a man.
5. 13:13 Love.

1 Corinthians 14

1. 14:2 Anyone who speaks in a tongue.
2. 14:3 Everyone who prophesies.
3. 14:6 What good will I be to you, unless I bring you some revelation or knowledge or prophecy or word of instruction?.
4. 14:9 Unless you speak intelligible words with your tongue.
5. 14:11 I am a foreigner to the speaker, and he is a foreigner to me.
6. 14:12 Gifts that build up the church.

8. 14:20 In regard to evil be infants, but in your thinking be adults.
9. 14:22 Believers.

12. 14:28 The speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and God.
13. 14:32 The spirits of prophets.
14. 14:35 For it is disgraceful for a woman to speak in the church.
15. 14:37 Let him acknowledge that what I am writing to you is the Lord's command.
16. 14:40 In a fitting and orderly way.

1 Corinthians 15

1. 15:1 The gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand.
2. 15:2 By this gospel you are saved.
3. 15:3-5 What I received: That Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter and then to the Twelve.
4. 15:5 Peter, and then to the Twelve.
5. 15:9 Because I persecuted the church of God.
