1 Corinthians 10:1-33, 12:1-11

1 Corinthians 10

1. 10:2,1 Our forefathers (they).
2. 10:3-4 For they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.
3. 10:5 God was not pleased with most of them.
4. 10:6 To keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did.
5. 10:8,1 Twenty-three thousand of our forefathers who committed sexual immorality (them).
6. 10:9,1 Some of our forefathers who tested the Lord (them).
7. 10:11 Us, on whom the fulfillment of the ages has come.
8. 10:12 Be careful that you don't fall.
9. 10:13 He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
10. 10:14 Idolatry.
11. 10:16 A participation in the body of Christ.
12. 10:19-20 No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God, and I do not want you to be participants with demons.
13. 10:21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons too; you cannot have a part in both the Lord's table and the table of demons.
14. 10:23 Not everything is beneficial, not everything is constructive.
15. 10:24 The good of others.
16. 10:25-26 For, "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it".
17. 10:27 Eat whatever is put before you without raising questions of conscience.
18. 10:31 Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do.
19. 10:33 For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved.
