1 Corinthians 12:12-31, 13:1-13, 15:1-11

1 Corinthians 12

1. 12:12 The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ.
2. 12:13 We--whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free.
3. 12:15 The foot, if it should say, "Because I am not a hand I do not belong to the body".
4. 12:18 Just as he wanted them to be.
5. 12:19 Where would the body be?.
6. 12:22 Those parts of the body that seem to be weaker.
7. 12:23 The parts that we think are less honorable.
8. 12:24-25 So that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.
9. 12:26 Every part.
10. 12:28 First of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those having gifts of healing, those able to help others, those with gifts of administration, and those speaking in different kinds of tongues.
