2 Corinthians 5

1. 5:1 We have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands.
2. 5:2 Longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling.
3. 5:4 So that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.
4. 5:5 As a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.
5. 5:6 That as long as we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord.
6. 5:7 By faith, not by sight.
7. 5:8 Away from the body and at home with the Lord.
8. 5:10 That each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.
9. 5:14 Because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.
10. 5:15 That those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.
11. 5:16 From a worldly point of view.
12. 5:17 He is a new creation; the old has gone, the new is come!.
13. 5:18 The ministry of reconciliation.
