1 Corinthians 3:1-23, 6:1-20, 8:1-13

1 Corinthians 3

1. 3:1 Not as spiritual, but as worldly--mere infants in Christ.
2. 3:2 For you were not yet ready for it.
3. 3:4 When one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos".
4. 3:7 Neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.
5. 3:10-11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.
6. 3:12-13 His work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light.
7. 3:13 The fire.
8. 3:16 That you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you.
9. 3:18 He should become a "fool" so that he may become wise.
10. 3:19-20 "He catches the wise in their craftiness", and again, "The Lord knows that the thoughts of the wise are futile".

1 Corinthians 6

1. 6:1 Dare he take it before the ungodly for judgment instead of before the saints?.
2. 6:4,3 We will judge angels; how much more the things of this life?.
3. 6:7 The very fact that you have lawsuits among you.
4. 6:9-10 Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.
5. 6:11 In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.
6. 6:12 Anything.
7. 6:15 The members of Christ.
8. 6:18 All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body.
9. 6:20,19 You are not your own; you were bought at a price.

1 Corinthians 8

1. 8:2 The man who thinks he knows something.
2. 8:4 We know that an idol is nothing at all in the world and that there is no God but one.
3. 8:5-6 Yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.
4. 8:7 Some people are still so accustomed to idols that when they eat such food they think of it as having been sacrificed to an idol, and since their conscience is weak, it is defiled.
5. 8:9 That the exercise of your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak.
6. 8:13 I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to fall.
