Luke 15

1. 15:2-3 Who: The Pharisees and the teachers of the law; About: Jesus; How: they muttered.
2. 15:6 I have found my lost sheep.
3. 15:7 One sinner who repents.
4. 15:9,8 A woman who has ten silver coins and loses one (when she finds it).
5. 15:12,11 Who: The younger son of a man who had two sons; To: His father; What happened: He divided his property between them (his two sons).
6. 15:14 After he had spent everything there was a severe famine in that whole country.
7. 15:16,13 The younger son (he).
8. 15:18-19 "Father I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired men".
9. 15:20 His father.
10. 15:22,13 Who: The father; To: His servants; About: The younger son.
11. 15:25 The older son.
12. 15:26,25 The older son (he).
13. 15:29,28 Who: The older brother; To: His father; In response to: His father went out and pleaded with him when he became angry and refused to go in.
14. 15:32 This brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.

Luke 16

1. 16:2,1 Who: A rich man; To: his manager; Why: the manager was accused of wasting his possessions.
2. 16:5-6 Who: The manager; To: the first one of his master's debtors; Reply: "Eight hundred gallons of olive oil".
3. 16:8 The people of this world.
4. 16:10 Whoever can be trusted with very little.
5. 16:11 Who will trust you with true riches?.
6. 16:13 Both God and Money.
7. 16:15 What is highly valued among men.
8. 16:18 Anyone who divorces his wife and marries another woman, and the man who marries a divorced woman.
9. 16:20,19 At the gate of the rich man (who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day).
10. 16:24,23 Who: The rich man; To: Abraham; Where: in hell.
11. 16:26 So that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.
12. 16:27-28 For I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.
13. 16:29,23,30 Who: Abraham; To: the rich man; Reply: "No, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent".
14. 16:31 If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets.

Luke 17

1. 17:3,2 It would be better to be thrown in to the sea with a millstone tied around your neck than to cause one of these little ones to sin.
2. 17:4 Forgive him.
3. 17:6 You can say to this mulberry tree, "Be uprooted and planted in the sea", and it will obey you.
4. 17:7-8 Would he not rather say, "Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink".
5. 17:10 "We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty".
6. 17:12 Ten men who had leprosy.
7. 17:14,12,13 Who: Jesus; To: ten men who had leprosy; What happened: as they went they were cleansed.
8. 17:15-16 One of the ten lepers who was healed -- and he was a Samaritan.
9. 17:19 Who: Jesus; To: the (Samaritan) leper who was healed and returned to thank him.
10. 17:20-21 Because the kingdom of God is within you.
11. 17:22 The time when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, but you will not see it.
12. 17:23-24 For the Son of Man in his day will be like the lightning, which flashes and lights up the sky from one end to the other.
13. 17:26-27 People were eating, drinking, marrying and being given in marriage up to the day Noah entered the ark. Then the flood came and destroyed them all.
14. 17:29 The day Lot left Sodom.
15. 17:31,30 On the day the Son of Man is revealed (that day).
16. 17:34,30 On the day the Son of Man is revealed (that night).
17. 17:35,30 On the day the Son of Man is revealed.
