## Luke 7

1. 7:22 What you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor.
2. 7:23 The man who does not fall away on account of me.
3. 7:27,24 John (this is the one).
4. 7:29 Because they had been baptized by John.
5. 7:31-34 For John the Baptist came neither eating nor drinking, and you say, "He has a demon." The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and you say, "Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and 'sinners'".
6. 7:38,37 A woman who had lived a sinful life in that town (she).
7. 7:39 He would know who is touching him and what kind of woman she is--that she is a sinner.
8. 7:42 Neither of them had money to pay him back.
9. 7:47 He who has been forgiven little.
10. 7:50 Your faith.

## Luke 8

1. 8:3,2 Some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: Mary (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out; Joanna the wife of Cuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others (these women).
2. 8:5 Some of the seed which fell along the path.
3. 8:6,5 The plants which came up from some seed which fell on rock.
4. 8:10,9,4 Who: Jesus; To: His disciples; In response to: His disciples asked him what this parable meant.
5. 8:14 Those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature.
6. 8:15 Those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.
7. 8:20-21 To: Jesus; Reply: "My mother and brothers are those who hear God's word and put it into practice".
8. 8:24 The wind and the raging waters.
9. 8:27,26 In the region of the Gerasenes (when he stepped ashore).
10. 8:29,27 The demon-possessed man (he).
11. 8:31,27,30 Many demons who had gone into the man (they).
12. 8:33 When the demons came out of the man and went into the pigs.
13. 8:41-42 Because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying.
14. 8:44,43 A woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years (she).
15. 8:47 Why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed.
16. 8:50 Who: Jesus; To: Jairus; When: He heard someone from the house of Jairus say "Your daughter is dead. Don't bother the teacher any more".
17. 8:54,55,49 Who: Jesus; To: The dead daughter of Jairus; What happened: Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up.

## Luke 12

1. 12:4 Those who kill the body and after that can do no more.
2. 12:5 Him, who after the killing of the body, has power to throw you into hell.
3. 12:8 Whoever acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man will also acknowledge him before the angels of God.
4. 12:11-12 For the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say.
5. 12:15 A man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.
6. 12:20,16 Who: God; To: A certain rich man.
7. 12:24 They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds!.
8. 12:26,25 Add a single hour to your life by worrying (this).
9. 12:28 How much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith!.
10. 12:31,30 Seek your Father's (his) kingdom.
11. 12:34 Where your treasure is.
12. 12:39 He would not have let his house be broken into.
13. 12:40 Because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him.
14. 12:44,43,42 The faithful and wise manager (that servant) whom the master finds doing so when he returns.
15. 12:46,45 That servant who says, "My master is taking a long time in coming," and he then begins to beat the menservants and maidservants and to eat and drink and get drunk.
16. 12:48 Much.
17. 12:56 This present time.
18. 12:58 Or he may drag you off to the judge, and the judge turn you over to the officer, and the officer throw you into prison.
