Luke 2

1. 2:43 His parents.
2. 2:46,43 The boy Jesus (him).
3. 2:48,43,49 Who: The boy Jesus' mother; To: The boy Jesus; Reply: "Why were you searching for me? Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?".
4. 2:52 Jesus.

Luke 3

1. 3:3,2 John son of Zechariah (he).
2. 3:4 "A voice of one calling in the desert, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him'".
3. 3:8 For I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham.
4. 3:9 Every tree that does not produce good fruit.
5. 3:10-11 Who: The crowd; Replied: John; Reply: "The man with two tunics should share with him who has none, and the one who has food should do the same".
6. 3:16,15 Who: John; To: the people; In response to: they were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if he might possibly be the Christ.
7. 3:19 Because of Herodias, his brother's wife, and all the other evil things he had done.
8. 3:22,21 Who: A voice from heaven; About: Jesus; When: when he was baptized and as he was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove.
9. 3:23 When he was about thirty years old.

Luke 9

1. 9:1 To drive out all demons and to cure diseases.
2. 9:3,1 Who: Jesus; To: The Twelve; When: He sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
3. 9:5 Shake the dust off your feet when you leave their town, as a testimony against them.
4. 9:7-9 Because some were saying that John had been raised from the dead, others that Elijah had appeared, and others that one of the prophets of long ago had come back to life. But Herod said, "I beheaded John. Who, then, is this I hear such things about?".
5. 9:10 Jesus and the apostles.
6. 9:12 So they can go to the surrounding villages and countryside and find food and lodging, because we are in a remote place here.
7. 9:17 The disciples.
8. 9:20-21 Who: Peter; In reply to: Jesus had asked his disciples, "But what about you? Who do you say I am?"; What happened: Jesus strictly warned them not to tell this to anyone.
9. 9:22 The elders, chief priests, and teachers of the law.
10. 9:23-24 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it.
11. 9:26 The Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.
12. 9:30-31 (Two men), Moses and Elijah.
13. 9:34,28 Peter, John and James (they).
14. 9:35-36 Who: A voice from the cloud; About: Jesus; What happened: When the voice had spoken, they found that Jesus was alone.
15. 9:39 A spirit.
16. 9:41,38 Who: Jesus; To: The man in the crowd who begged him to look at his son.
17. 9:42 Jesus.
18. 9:45,44 What it meant when Jesus said "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men".
19. 9:48,46 Who: Jesus; To: His disciples; In response to: The argument started among the disciples as to which of them would be the greatest.
20. 9:51 The time for Jesus to be taken up to heaven.
21. 9:53,52 The people in the Samaritan village (where Jesus had sent messengers on ahead).
22. 9:58,57 Who: Jesus; In reply to: A man said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go".
23. 9:62 Service in the kingdom of God.

Luke 10

1. 10:2 The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.
2. 10:3 Like lambs among wolves.
3. 10:7 For the worker deserves his wages.
4. 10:9,8 When you enter a town and are welcomed.
5. 10:11 The kingdom of God is near.
6. 10:14,13 For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.
7. 10:19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy.
8. 10:21 Little children.
9. 10:23-24 Many prophets and kings wanted to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it.
