1. As He approached the town gate, He saw what?  
7:12 A dead man being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow
2. When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said, what?  
7:13 "Do not weep."
3. sit Who, To whom, Result: "Young man, I tell you, get up!"  
7:14 \* Jesus \* A dead man, the only son of his mother \* And the dead man sat up and began to speak!
4. ref According to Luke chapter 7 verse 16, Who glorified God?  
7:16 They (All of them / a sizeable crowd from the town)
5. What spread throughout Judea and all the surrounding region?  
7:17 The news about Jesus
6. So John called two of his disciples and sent them to ask the Lord, what?  
7:19 "Are You the One who was to come, or should we look for someone else?"
7. At that very hour Jesus healed many people of what?  
7:21 Their diseases, afflictions, and evil spirits
8. What have you seen and heard?  
7:22 The blind receive sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor
9. ref According to Luke chapter 7 verse 23, Who is blessed?  
7:23 The one who does not fall away on account of Me."
10. sit Who, To whom, When: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed swaying in the wind?  
7:24 \* Jesus \* The crowds \* After John's messengers had left
11. Who are found in palaces?  
7:25 Those who wear elegant clothing and live in luxury
12. What then did you go out to see?  
7:26 A prophet / Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet
13. ref According to Luke chapter 7 verse 27, What is written?  
7:27 'Behold, I will send My messenger ahead of You, who will prepare Your way before You.'
14. Who is greater than he?  
7:28 Even the least in the kingdom of God
15. All the people who heard this, even the tax collectors, acknowledged God's justice why?  
7:29 For they had received the baptism of John
16. The Pharisees and experts in the law rejected what?  
7:30 God's purpose for themselves
17. To what, then, can I compare the men of this generation?  
7:31 They are like children sitting in the marketplace and calling out to one another: 'We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we sang a dirge, and you did not weep.'
18. For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine, and you say, what?  
7:33 'He has a demon!'
19. ref According to Luke chapter 7 verse 34, The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and you say, what?  
7:34 'Look at this glutton and drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!'
20. When a sinful woman from that town learned that Jesus was dining there, she brought what?  
7:37 An alabaster jar of perfume
21. Who stood behind Him at His feet weeping?  
7:38 She (A sinful woman from that town)
22. When the Pharisee who had invited Jesus saw this, he said to himself, what?  
7:39 "If this man were a prophet, He would know who this is and what kind of woman is touching Him-for she is a sinner!"
23. sit Who, To whom, Reply: "Tell me, Teacher,"  
7:40 \* Simon / The Pharisee who had invited Jesus \* Jesus \* "Two men were debtors to a certain moneylender. One owed him five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they were unable to repay him, he forgave both of them. Which one, then, will love him more?"
24. sit Who, To whom, About whom: "Do you see this woman? When I entered your house, you did not give Me water for My feet, but she wet My feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair.  
7:44 \* Jesus \* Simon / The Pharisee who had invited Jesus \* The woman / A sinful woman from that town

25. You did not anoint My head with oil, but she has anointed My feet with what?  
7:46 Perfume
26. What have been forgiven?  
7:47 Her many sins
27. But those at the table began to say to themselves, what?  
7:49 "Who is this who even forgives sins?"

Luke 8

1. Jesus traveled from one town and village to another, how?  
8:1 Preaching and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God
2. Who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities?  
8:2 Mary called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out, Joanna  
the wife of Herod's household manager Chuza, Susanna, and many others
3. These women were ministering to them out of what?  
8:3 Their own means
4. What fell along the path, where it was trampled?  
8:5 Some seed
5. And when it came up, the seedlings withered why?  
8:6 Because they had no moisture
6. Still other seed fell on good soil, where it sprang up and produced what?  
8:8 A crop-a hundredfold
7. What knowledge has been given to you?  
8:10 The knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of God
8. The devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, why?  
8:12 So that they may not believe and be saved
9. Who fall away in the time of testing?  
8:13 They (The seeds on rocky ground / those who hear the word and  
receive it with joy)
10. The seeds that fell among the thorns are those who hear, but as they go on  
their way, they are choked by what?  
8:14 The worries, riches, and pleasures of this life
11. But the seeds on good soil are those with what?  
8:15 A noble and good heart
12. Instead, he sets it on a stand, why?  
8:16 So those who enter can see the light
13. For there is nothing hidden that will not be what?  
8:17 Disclosed
14. Jesus' mother and brothers came to see Him, but they were unable to reach Him  
why?  
8:19 Because of the crowd
15. Who are My mother and brothers?  
8:21 Those who hear the word of God and carry it out
16. What came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped?  
8:23 A windstorm
17. Then Jesus got up and rebuked what?  
8:24 The wind and the raging waters
18. sit Who, To whom, About whom: "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the  
water, and they obey Him!"  
8:25 \* The disciples \* One another \* Jesus
