Ephesians 3

1. 3:5,4 The mystery of Christ.
2. 3:6 That through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.
3. 3:7 By the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power.
4. 3:10 That now through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms.
5. 3:12 Freedom and confidence.
6. 3:15,14 His whole family in heaven and on earth.
7. 3:16-17 So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.
8. 3:18,17 How wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.
9. 3:19 To the measure of all the fullness of God.
10. 3:20,19 God (him).

Ephesians 4

1. 4:1 To live a life worthy of the calling you have received.
2. 4:3 The unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
3. 4:7 As Christ apportioned it.
4. 4:10 In order to fill the whole universe.
5. 4:11-13 To prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.
6. 4:14 Infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming.
7. 4:17 That you must no longer live as the Gentiles do in the futility of their thinking.
8. 4:18 Because of the ignorance that is in them due to their hardening of their hearts.
9. 4:19 Having lost all sensitivity, to indulge in every kind of impurity with a continual lust for more.
10. 4:21 In accordance with the truth that is in Jesus.
11. 4:22-24 To put off your old self which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.
12. 4:25 For we are all members of one body.
13. 4:28 That he may have something to share with those in need.
14. 4:30 The Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
15. 4:32 Forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
