Ephesians 5

1. 5:2 Just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
2. 5:3 Because these are improper for God's holy people.
3. 5:4 Obscenity, foolish talk, coarse joking.
4. 5:5 No immoral, impure or greedy person has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
5. 5:6 For because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient.
6. 5:8-9 (For the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth).
7. 5:10 What pleases the Lord.
8. 5:11-12 For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret.
9. 5:15-16 Because the days are evil.
10. 5:17,16 Because the days are evil.
11. 5:18 The Spirit.
12. 5:19-20 Always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
13. 5:21 Out of reverence for Christ.
14. 5:23 As Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.
15. 5:24 As the church submits to Christ.
16. 5:25-27 To make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
