1. 4:14-16 "Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, along the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles--the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned".
2. 4:17 The kingdom of heaven.
3. 4:18 As he was walking beside the Sea of Galilee.
4. 4:19 Who: Jesus; Response: At once Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew left their nets and followed him.
5. 4:21 James son of Zebedee and his brother John.
6. 4:23 Teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

1. 5:3 For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
